In cases which have to be submitted to the Classing Committee "the endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—(Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to the sternframe and rudder being specially examined next drydocking, and to chafed stem plating being examined and dealt with as necessary by the next Special Survey, with Endorsement (B).

A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 6,52.

In reply to a query in respect of the Special Survey of this ship, the Owners now advise that she is at present laid up at Gibraltar but will be towed to the U.K. in early October 1952, and on arrival it is proposed to lay her up in reserve without undergoing refit or Special Survey, and they do not wish to Classification with this Society.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the ship's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' convenience.
