R.F.A. BOXOL

With reference to your letter dated 8th September, 1952, I have to inform you that the tow of R.F.A. BOXOL from Gibraltar to United Kingdom has been delayed and will now take place early in October, 1952.

2. Meanwhile, R.F.A. BOXOL has been temporarily laid up at Gibraltar.

3. On arrival in United Kingdom it is now proposed to lay the vessel up in reserve without undergoing refit or special survey, and no objection is seen to withdrawing the ship's classification forthwith.
