This is to CERTIFY that as per instructions received from Mr. Basil Hone, Lloyd's Agent at Havana, Cuba, acting on behalf of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, and in response to a request from the Master, through Ship's Agents, Empresa Consolidada de Consignatarias Mambisas, the undersigned surveyor, Jesús Meirás, Chief Engineer, Retired, did attend on December 21st and December 24th, 1968, the S/S "ACME", Cyprus flag, of 7173 gross registered tons, while she lay afloat and moored to "Sierra Maestra #3" Wharf, at Havana Harbour, to carry out Starboard Boiler Survey, and that I am transmitting that all my recommendations have been carried out to my entire satisfaction and that, in my opinion, a record of fresh A.B.S. may be assigned with this date.

PARTS NOW EXAMINED:

Starboard Boiler (Bacok-Wilcox) opened up and examined, including air heaters - superheaters - all valves including safety valves, safety valves springs, mountings, doors and fastenings, boiler securing arrangements, oil burning system and remote controls were examined and tested satisfactorily.

Brick work was examined and brick work of all four mouths of furnace. Tube plates and dome.

The work pressure of boiler is of 225 lbs. per s.i. The work pressure at superheaters is of 230 lbs. p.s.i.

The safety valves were adjusted and discharged at 230 lbs. p.s.i.
