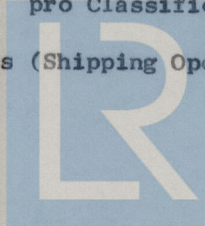
1. The main condenser water box being specially examined by the end of April, 1969.
2. The windlass steam valve chest being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by April, 1969.

In order to complete the starboard Main Boiler Survey, due at the end of October last, the starboard main boiler remains to be examined throughout and its safety valves adjusted. It is concluded that you will make the necessary arrangements in this respect.
