ANSWER.

Date:— Reykjavik 11/2 '52.

The "FAXI" was laid up, and was anchored at Hafnarfjörður, but in heavy snow storm on the 5th January last the shain cables broke, and she "sailed" away, out of the Hafnarfjörður, and passed there many other vessels without tuching them, and drifted over 30 miles to the north, and "sailed" through many skerries on her way, and grounded on a sand bank (To the Owners grate disappointment) in Borgarfjörður.

They managed to get her off the sand bank under her own power. The vessel will probably be placed on the slippway to morrow for examination. It is expected that she is very little damaged.
