With reference to your memorandum of the 31st August last, I shall be glad to learn whether this vessel is still laid up.

The " FAXI " was laid up , and was anchored at Hafnarfjörður , but in heavy snow storm on the 5th January last the chain cables broke , and she "sailed" away , out of the Hafnarfjörður , and passed there many other vessels without touching them , and drifted over 30 miles to the north , and " sailed " through many skerries on her way , and grounded on a sand bank (To the Owners grate disappointment) in Borgarfjörður .

They managed to get her off the sand bank under her own power . The vessel will probably be placed on the slipway to morrow for examination . It is expected that she is very little damaged .
