The vessel was placed on Slipway, carefully examined, and the following damages found and repaired, Port side.

- Plate E.1. slightly indented, faired in place.
- Plate E.2. slightly indented, faired in place.
- Plate F.3. indented, removed, faired and refitted.
- 3 Frames bent and broken, partly renewed.
- 5 Frames bent, heated and faired in place.
- 5 beamknees bent and fractured, renewed.
