With reference to your letter of the 13th instant regarding the tanker "PAULA", I have to confirm the intimation given to Mr. Barker this afternoon that the Committee will be agreeable to the Society's Surveyors at Singapore issuing a certificate of fitness for a voyage from that port to Italy provided, upon examination, they are entirely satisfied with her condition for this voyage.

Any question of drydocking and the amount of cargo to be carried will be left for their decision.

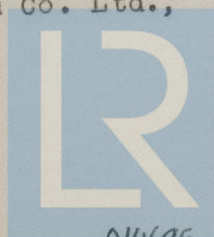
Such certificate should not, of course, be regarded as a classification certificate seeing that the temporary class assigned has expired, but I trust it will suit your purpose and also enable the Dutch Authorities to issue a load line certificate.
