On the 1st ultimo the Owners stated that they did not intend to use this vessel for further deep sea trading, but possibly as a bunkering craft at Singapore. Before any decision was made, however, they wished to know whether she would be suitable for bunkering purposes and requested that her class might be extended for a month to allow the vessel to be tried out in the above duties. This was agreed to by the Committee on the 2nd ultimo, later extended until the 7th instant.

The attached letter has now been received from the Owners intimating that they have received an offer for the vessel which would mean her proceeding to Italy. In the circumstances they request that a seaworthy certificate for this voyage might be issued. They also state that they anticipate carrying cargo, either a full cargo or part cargo and part ballast, depending upon the Committee's decision.

They add that all essential repairs for the proposed voyage would be dealt with at Singapore.
