The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

"The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This tug is 47 years old, and a SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 7, 1952.

The Owners' proposal to deal with the Special Survey in September 1952 was agreed to.

The LONDON Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat and recommendations made for repairs to worn stringer plating, wasted main framing throughout, and badly wasted shell plating throughout.

The Owners have now declared their intention of removing the vessel from class.

In the circumstances therefore IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel's class be expunged with a black line (—) indicating reported defects.
