Dear Mr. Bradshaw,

The Superintendent of the Hopper Barges, "Joseph Philip" and "J. Hannay Thompson," which are sister ships with the exception of wood sheathing over the crew's quarters fore., which is fitted in the case of the "J. Hannay Thompson," has drawn my attention to slight differences of the marking in the case of the vessels, that is to say, the T.F.T. and W.N.A.

In the case of the "J. Hannay Thompson," you will remember, as a guide I sent a copy of the existing B.O.T. certificate, and the letter forwarded, agrees with this. As these vessels are on a restricted service, might I suggest that the "Joseph Philip" be altered (with regard to the T.F.T. and W.N.A.) to agree with the "J. Hannay Thompson."

Two Owners letters are enclosed and also the two blue letters forwarded to this Office, and I am now waiting for your advice on the matter.

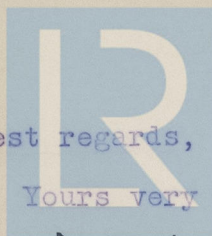
