Moulded displacement at a moulded draught equal to 85% of the moulded depth = 1477 tons.

External displacement at extreme draught of 13 feet = 1505 tons.  
Tons per inch 10.55.

External displacement at extreme draught of 13'6" = 1570 tons.  
Tons per inch 10.65.
