In order to comply with the Government, the original test certificates of the Boilermaterial, test of boilers, drawings of boilers, crankshaft, thrustshaft Int. shaft, screwshaft, M.E. driven pumps and diameters of cylinders are required, and the new Owners would therefore be very much obliged if you could furnish them with the documents in question.

The "ST. KILDA" was built in 1942 by Hall & Co. Ltd. at Aberdeen. The "ARRAN" was built in 1941 by Cook, Wilton & Gemel at Beverly; Engine and boiler by Holmes at Hull.
