I shall be glad to receive a reply to the enquiry contained in my letter of the 21st November last respecting the carrying out of the Water Tube Donkey Boiler Survey of the Motorship "BAHIA THETIS".

At the same time, I shall be glad if you will point out to the Owners that although the Society's Rules require classed ships to be examined in drydock at intervals of approximately one year, the last examination in drydock of this ship, according to the records here, was carried out in April 1950.

I shall therefore be glad if you will discuss this matter with the Owners with a view to an examination in drydock being carried out at an early date, and let me know what arrangements they propose making in the matter.
