
We have had a further letter from Mr. Mavor about the case of the steamer "ALIWAL", on which it has been decided to carry out a full Classification Survey at your Port for the Registro Italiano.

We do not think there is any useful purpose served by discussing the matter any further with Dr. Solda of the Registro Italiano.

We consider it was well worth while drawing his attention to the case, although his Society will now have the classification of the vessel.

It is likely that the Registro Italiano will be more careful in the future when accepting a ship for classification which has been in another Register.
