Further to my letter of the 18th January concerning the above Vessel, I have again seen Dr. Soldà on this subject and he informs me that a telegram has now been received from the Registro Italiano Representative at Durban, who states that the certificate issued by him for the voyage Durban to Cape Town has been withdrawn as requested but that the Owners have now decided to carry out a full Classification Survey at Durban.

I also obtained copy of the Registro Italiano memorandum on this case a translation/<sup>of</sup> which is attached herewith for your information.

It would therefore appear that the Owners have decided to class the ship with the Registro Italiano.

In conclusion, I should like to emphasize that Dr. Soldà was most co-operative in this case, as on receiving the facts as given in your Memorandum of the 4th January, he immediately gave instructions for the withdrawal of the Certificate issued by the R.I. Representative for the voyage to Cape Town.

Dr. Soldà asks me to convey his thanks to you for bringing the case to his notice.
