The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 11th May last and in reply to the Owners' request to postpone the Special Survey for twelve months they were informed that the inspection in question must be held at its due date if the vessel was to retain her Class. In reply to this communication the Owners expressed surprise at the Committee's decision and threatened to Class the vessel with another Classification Society.

The case again received the consideration of the Committee on the 22nd May and their previous decision was adhered to.

On the 14th June the Durban Surveyors stated that they had been informed by the Owners that the requisite inspection would be carried out at the end of that month as required by the Committee.

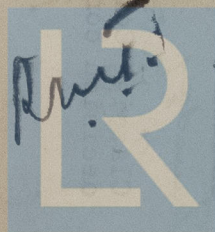
