I beg to acquaint you that "Vic" Lighters Nos. 22, 74, 83 and 92 are here for classification survey at the request of the Owners, Messrs. West Coast Lines, Ltd., (R.M. Nazir, Manager) Registered Office, 27, Queens Road, Bombay.

It is understood that these vessels were built under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors and the scantlings are such as can be recommended for 100A- "For Coasting Service" but, I shall be glad if you will confirm this.

These vessels are at present undergoing Special Survey of Hull and Machinery and for Assignment of Load Line and no plans of any description are available. I shall be glad to learn, therefore, if a First Entry Report is required on these vessels and their machinery and if so, if the necessary plans may be obtained from the builders.

It is stated the boiler workings pressure is 120 lbs. and I shall be glad to have confirmation of this.
