

We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to **Act as the Representative of the Whangpoo Conservancy Board, in collaboration with Mr. W. Smith, the Board's Special Representative, during the construction and all trials, dockings and machinery examinations, etc., of the Drag Suction Dredger now being built by Messrs. Schichau G.m.b.H. Elbing, until the vessel is accepted or rejected at Shanghai in accordance with the contract draft dated 1st November, 1933. (effective no 27th)**

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, ~~in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.~~ **Namely £1250 inclusive.**

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
