the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of W.A. Parker of Marine Castings & Supply Co. examine and test the 19th May, 1947, one Spencer Hopwood Vertical Boiler SB943 No 22, intended for the M.V. "HERMETRAY".

This boiler, which was evidently unused, was examined, scantlings checked and plate numbers noted where possible.

It was, as far as could be ascertained, of sound material and good workmanship. A hydraulic test of 275 lb. per square inch was witnessed and the boiler found tight and sound.

For identification purposes the shell above the firing door was stamped:-
