S. Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th instant and note that the Danlayer "HERMETRAY" has been purchased by the N.V. Scheepvaart^{inget}chappy Andromeda of Rotterdam, and is now undergoing repairs in drydock at your port prior to proceeding to Rotterdam.

This vessel was built under the Society's survey and is at present classed #100A-Steam Trawler, "For Government Service" and will become due for Special Survey in August 1948. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners' representatives to this effect and advise them that when the vessel was built no cement was stated to have been laid on the bottom. The question of cementing the bottom, especially under the boiler, will require to be considered in the event of the notation "For Government Service" being deleted from the vessel's class.

It will be in order for you to inspect the repairs being carried out on this vessel and issue a Cert.B in due course.
