I beg to advise you that the above unclassed vessel has been bought by N.V. Scheepvaartschappy Andromeda of Rotterdam from the Director of Small Craft Disposals. This vessel was built by Messrs Cochrane of Selby in 1944, and is at present in dry dock in Dundee undergoing repairs on account of damage to stern plating, rudder, propeller, tail shaft, etc. The Owners have requested us to survey the repairs now being carried out. They state that it is their intention to submit this vessel for classification with Lloyd's Register, but this will not be done until the vessel reaches Rotterdam. Meantime, they have asked that an Interim Certificate be given for the vessel's voyage to that port.

It will be appreciated if instructions in this case can be sent by return of post.
