
The screw shaft is stated to have suffered damage during war service and on examination was found to be bent.

A new shaft has been fitted at this time. The Surveyor states that the new shaft has been supplied from Admiralty stock. Brinell check tests have been taken and found to be satisfactory. The Surveyor has recommended that the shaft might be accepted and the Glasgow Committee have referred this question to the London Committee in view of the vessel's class bearing the characteristic α .

IT IS SUBMITTED that the acceptance of this shaft might be approved without the vessel's class being affected.
