Dear Sirs,

With reference to Hull Report No. 52557 on the Danlayer "HERMETRAY" (J.2692), it is observed that, in computing the fees due in respect of Classification and Supervision of the Specification, an adjustment has been made in the Specification fee to bring the combined Classification and Specification fees in line with the correct total. This is not in order, as the fees in question should be treated quite independently.

In view of the fact that the fee stated on West Hartlepool Report No. 18553 exceeds 2/5ths of the agreed total Classification fee (£39) by £2.2.0., the balance due to Hull account should have been shewn as £21.6.0. instead of £23.8.0. The sum of £2.2.0. having been over-charged and paid in respect of the machinery Classification fee, it is considered advisable, with a view to obviating complications at a later date, that this sum should be refunded to the Engine Makers, and I have to request that you will be good enough to arrange accordingly.

An account has today been rendered to the Director of Navy Accounts in respect of the full Specification fees, in accordance with the agreed scale, and, in due course, your account will be credited with the following sums in respect thereof -

The balance of £14.8.0. will be credited to West Hartlepool account in respect of the boilers.

The fees entered on the Report in question have been amended in accordance with the foregoing.
