Nature of Survey

~~REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH~~

This Drilling Barge has been built under Special Survey but classification of the Machinery is not desired and Owners have asked that the Electric Installation and Pumping Arrangements be in accordance with the Rules.

The Rotterdam Surveyors have issued Rpts. 10 dated 19.3.56., respecting the Electric Installation and dated 16.3.56., for Pumping Arrangements.

The Alternators, main Switchboard and several motors were supplied by Owners and were not built under Survey. The installation is in accordance with plans submitted and was tested on completion. The following detail does not comply with the Rule:-

"Phase sequence indicator not fitted at terminals of shore supply connection."

The Pumping Arrangements, air and sounding pipes installed in accordance with approved plans and tested to Rule Requirements on completion. Pumps supplied by Owners and not built under Survey.
