I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for DOCKING SURVEY, REPAIR TO RUDDER AND CONDITION OF CLASS.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Docking Survey - Shell plating, stern frame and rudder cleaned, examined and recoated.

Wear & Tear Repairs - Clearance of top rudder bush found excessive.

Now Done - Top rudder bush rewooded in position and without having to lift rudder.

CONDITION OF CLASS (S.R.L. No. 217)

Indented shell plates No. 6 in 3rd & Nos. 5 & 6 in 4th below (Port side) to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking. No. 3 sheer from forward (stbd. side) to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking.

Now Done - All specially examined and found to continue efficient.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with ~~without~~ fresh record of dry docking DS 4/64 subject to all outstanding conditions being dealt with as previously recommended.


