of the M.S. "SSCO ORBENTON" 77 gross tons of London
for completion of C.S.M. and Docking,

and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following survey records assigned C.S.M. 4.65 subject to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.

Parts now examined:—

Main engine No. 1 cylinder, liner, cover, piston, valves and gears, gudgeon pin and bearings, connecting rod, crankpin and bearing.
Main engine driven scavenge pump cylinder, cover, piston, gudgeon pin and bearings, connecting rod, crankpin and bearing.
Scavenge pump crankshaft journal and bearing.
Holding down bolts and checks.
Port and starboard main engine driven lubricating oil pumps.
Main engine attached fuel pumps.
Crankcase doors and explosion relief devices.
Main engine working and manoeuvring.

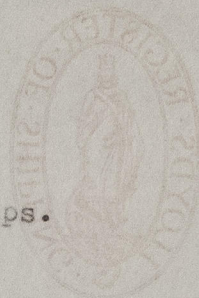
