I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant in further reference to this case, and in reply have to inform you that provided the Surveyors are satisfied that the plating and rivets are adequately protected, the covering of bitumastic solution and enamel will be accepted in lieu of cement.

In the cases of the "BETTY" and "WINNIE", and in future similar cases, however, it is recommended that a somewhat thicker covering, say from $\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ ", should be applied.
