"FORESAIL"	-	S.S. 1,60	Last Drydocking Date 12,61.

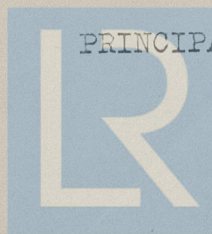
In view of the condition of the above ships as found at the last drydocking it is submitted that the next drydocking be at the next Special Survey. Ships in the meantime considered efficient.
