We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 925 building by Messrs. Kawasaki Dockyard Company, Ltd., Kobe for Messrs. Caribbean Land & Shipping Corp. of abt. 18,000 Tons. Length 181.00^M, Breadth 25.40^M, Depth 13.50^M intended to be Classed +100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk".

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
