In answer to your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding First Entry Report No. 32238 on the Steel Screw Steamer "CAVENDISH" ex "WILLIAM LEEK", I beg to state that the size of bilge keelson should have been stated to be 5" x 5" x 8/20ths to 7/20ths at ends.

The upper deck stringer plate thicknesses are 6/16ths to .28 at ends.

The length of the raised Quarter Deck is 71.75 feet, and I regret that these clerical errors should have appeared on this report.
