

EX-ADMIRALTY CASTLE TYPE TRAWLER "WILLIAM LEEK"
to be re-named "CAVENDISH"

This vessel was built by Messrs. J. P. Rennoldson & Sons under the British Corporation Survey to plans mutually approved by L.R. & B.C. for this class of trawler.

The vessel has undergone reconditioning for trawl fishing, and it is the wish of the Managers - Messrs. Hudson Bros. - to have the vessel now classed with Lloyd's Register.

It is submitted the Hull Surveyors be informed that vessels of the Castle Type of trawler were built to plans mutually approved by this Society & British Corporation.

In order that the vessel may be classed with this Society it will be necessary for the Surveyors to carry out a Special Survey ~~on~~ ^{the} *the Engines & Boilers* on the vessel, to verify the Scantlings as far as possible, and to forward First Entry Reports duly filled in.

A plan of midship section and profile of the "Castle" type of trawler is enclosed for the general guidance of the Surveyors and should be returned to this Office when finished with.
