I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 20th and 22nd instant regarding the S.S. "BELFRI", and your remarks have been duly noted.

With regard thereto I think it well to inform you that on the 17th instant a letter was received from the Society's Surveyors at Oslo submitting a proposal in respect of alterations to Nos. 1 and 2 hatchways, but it was not until the next day that a letter was received stating that the vessel was being submitted for classification with this Society. The plans were examined without delay and were returned the next day (19th instant), a wire being sent at that time with regard to the proposal to alter the hatchway arrangements.

It will therefore be seen that there has been no delay in the matter.
