Copy of a letter received from the Society's Surveyor, T.Moon,
Esq., Halifax. N.S. Dated 26th February. Received 12th March, 1921

Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter (S) of the 11th instant enclosing certificates of class for the steamers, "CANADIAN MARINER" & "CANADIAN SAPPER", also for the wood 3 masted schooner "ANNA MACDONALD". The certificates for the "CANADIAN MARINER" & "CANADIAN SAPPER" will be forwarded to the Builders, the fees having been paid. The certificate for the schooner "ANNA MACDONALD" will be held until the fees have been paid. The shell plating in the double bottom and peaks in the steamer "CANADIAN MARINER" is protected by cement, and a record of "Cem." should be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel.

Regarding the steamer "CANADIAN SAPPER" I am advised by Mr. MacArthur, the Society's Surveyor at New Glasgow, that the sheerstrake is doubled at the ends of the bridge as approved.

I have requested Mr. MacArthur, the Society's Surveyor at New Glasgow, to forward the approved plans of the "ANNA MACDONALD" 1306 for filing with the report.
