In reply to the enquiry the HONG KONG Surveyors have advised by cablegram received 15.10.56 that the class of the above named ship has been transferred to the Bureau Veritas.

The SPECIAL SURVEY (B) (due 7,56) has not been held and the General Examination for postponement of this Survey has been commenced but not completed, the Surveyors reporting that in view of the extensive repairs required at this time the Owners had decided to discontinue the Survey pending a decision regarding the future of this ship which was sold to the present Owners who have not carried out anything further with regard to Survey or repairs so far as the Society is concerned.

IT IS SUBMITTED for the consideration of the Committee therefore, whether the class of this ship be EXPUNGED for reported defects OR for non-compliance with the Regulations.
