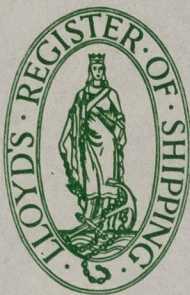

# LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING



surveyed the M.S. "LUCIANO CASTRO" <sup>600</sup> gross tons of Santos  
on account of Damage Repairs and Completion of S.S. whilst  
afloat and drydocked at Santos on the 29th December 1964 and  
subsequently

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of  
Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by  
me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am  
recommending that she be reinstated in class with the notation S.S.  
4/64 as previously recommended, and D.S. 3/65 and without being  
subject to the bottom shell plating being examined, but subject  
to the full complement of chain cable being renewed earliest  
opportunity. Subject to all other conditions, at present attached  
to the ship's class by the Society's Surveyors, being dealt with
