This vessel was built in 1943 as an L.S.T. for the American Navy, now converted to a tanker and Classification with this Society is now desired.

First Entry Reports, together with some plans approved in the New York Office, have been examined and the details are such as could be accepted.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock and the requirements of LMC, DBS and Screw Shaft Surveys carried out.

The torsional vibration characteristics have not been investigated. The Machinery Certificate should be endorsed accordingly. The Owners should be advised and our services offered to make the necessary investigation, if desired.
