With regard to your remarks, I have to acquaint you that the figure of 14.14 sq. inches given in the first entry report for the total area through the donkey boiler safety valves would satisfy the requirements of the Rules if an approved type of high lift safety valve were fitted.

In this connexion I should be glad if you would kindly state whether the type of valve fitted has been approved in ^{your} this Office, as the report gives the makers of the safety valves as the Crosby Steam Gage Co., concerning which I would refer you to my letter of the 29th ultimo, regarding the motorships "LOUISIANA" and "FLORIDA".


