The attached letter has been received from the Buenos Aires Surveyors intimating that the Owners request that the Donkey Boiler Survey be postponed until January, 1953. The Surveyors, in reply, informed the Owners that this proposal was not being submitted for the consideration of the Committee as they felt that the Committee would insist that the survey be carried out without further delay, or, alternatively, that the donkey boiler pressure beexpunged from the Register Book and an undertaking given that the boiler would not be used again until fully surveyed. At the same time the Surveyors pointed out to the Owners that the Special Survey becomes due at the end of next month.

The Surveyors add they have been informed verbally by the Owners that the donkey boiler is required for use in port and that they do not wish to incur the delay and expense of carrying out the Donkey Boiler Survey. Further, the Surveyors state that it is most improbable that the Owners will submit the vessel for Special Survey. They will again communicate when they have received a written reply from the Owners.


