Dear Sirs,

Tank Barge "STONEWEAR"

The Committee have to-day had before them the case of the above named vessel in the light of the comments contained in your letter of the 2nd instant.

They note that you anticipate arriving at a decision in regard to this case within the next few weeks, but they desire me to point out that the Special Survey on the barge became due so long ago as May, 1951, and that the year of grace allowed by them expired last May.

They therefore feel that if the vessel is to retain her class, they must request you to make definite arrangements for the Special Survey to be put in hand, or at any rate, for the barge to be taken off service before the end of this month.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly let me know at an early date, for their information, what arrangements you are making in the matter.
