Dear Sir,

With reference to your memoranda of the 22nd and 29th ultimo, respecting the Barges "STONECROFT" (ex "DESTONE") and "STONEWEAR" (ex "FASTONE") respectively, we have now to inform you that both these barges have been engaged for more than twelve months in the heavy oil trade requiring no P.L.A. Licence. These barges, however, are being brought to Erith shortly with a view to the Owners carrying out a private survey to decide whether they can be considered economically repairable for continuance of Class and re-issue of P.L.A. Licence.

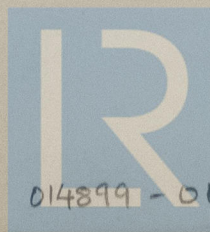
It is hoped that a decision will be made before the end of the present month and the Owners will be communicating direct to Head Office in the matter.
