Dear Sirs,

Transversely Framed Tanker "BRITANSEA"

Reverting to my letter of the 24th October, I have to inform you that the report of survey carried out in October last by the Society's Surveyors at New York has now come to hand, and I have to inform you that the Committee have confirmed their agreement to the Special Survey being postponed until June next, as desired by you, and to the fitting of under-deck inter-costal girders also being deferred until that time.

During the course of the above inspection, temporary repairs were effected to the condenser circulating pump, which was found to be holed in way of liquid end and division plates. It is recommended that the liquid end should be renewed before the end of February next, and the water box at the first opportunity, and the vessel's class has been continued subject to these matters receiving attention.


A notation of DBS 5,52 has been assigned in respect of the Donkey Boiler Survey, which was also held, together with a record of docking 10,52.
