Dear Sirs,

It is understood that the steamer "INCHCOLM" No.13399 in the Register Book is now proceeding to your port where modifications are to be made to adapt her for cargo carrying.

She was previously classed ~~EL~~LOCA- "For Government Service" and a full Special Survey has now been carried out at Birkenhead prior to her being handed over to her new Owners, the Medway Yacht Basin Ltd.

The class has been amended to ~~EL~~LOCA- "With Freeboard" together with notations of S.S. Bkn.11,51. ~~EL~~MC 11,51. and T.S. 10,51. - "For Government Service" having been deleted.

The load line certificate for the voyage to Genoa has been issued by the Society following a full Freeboard Survey at Liverpool.

I enclose herewith copy of a letter dated 18th instant addressed to the Liverpool Office from which you will see that we are pressing for the equipment to be brought up to the Society's requirements for the insertion of the figure '1' in her class.

When any decision comes to hand from the Owners I will let you know.
