Dear Sir,

With reference to Liverpool Report No.134289 on the steamer "INCHCOLM", it is considered that in view of the freeboard which is being assigned to this ship her class should be ~~8100A~~ "With Freeboard", and not ~~8100A-~~. Perhaps therefore you will be good enough to amend your Minute of the 18th ultimo accordingly.

At the same time I shall be glad if you will point out to the Owners that for the figure '1' in the ship's class, a bower anchor, stream anchor and 30 fathoms of cable will require to be supplied in accordance with Table 53, equipment letter "g" provided, of course, the Surveyors are satisfied that the present equipment on board is in order.

It is strongly recommended the Owners, for their own protection, should adopt this suggestion, and I shall be obliged if you will make representations to them accordingly.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Genoa Surveyors where it is understood further alterations will be carried out.
