Sir,

Please find enclosed Reports 8 and 9 on "ISLE OF SILHOUETTE"
are self-explanatory.

The Ownership is still in dispute and none of the Claimants
prepared to spend money on the vessel until ownership is
settled, in the meanwhile the machinery and electrical
installations which were flooded are not being attended to with
consequent detriment to the installations.

For the private information of the Committee I have
advised that the Portuguese crew have not been paid for some
time and I do not think they are prepared to open up the
machinery for cleaning out or overhaul.

I have recommended that the vessel be expunged from the
Register Book with the notation 8.54 on account of the above

condition also in view of the severe straining she sustained
when beached and the condition of shell due to marine termites.
