Reverting to my letter of the 9th instant, I have to inform you that a reply has now come to hand by cable from the Society's Surveyors at Singapore as follows:-

"REURCAB FUSUS REPAIRS FOR BALLAST VOYAGE VANCOUVER SIMILAR AS PER OURCABE 26TH JUNE STOP OWNERS LOCAL SUPERINTENDENT STATES PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS REPRESENTATIVE ARRIVING HERE NEXT WEEK"

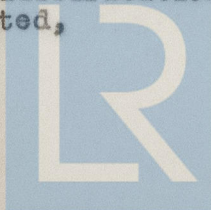
The text of the cablegram dated 26th June last, to which reference is made by the Surveyors in the above quoted communication, reads as follows:-

"REURCAB 15 JUNE FUSUS LAID UP APPROXIMATELY SEVEN MONTHS NOW GENERALLY EXAMINED IN UNPREPARED STATE AS FAR AS PRACTICABLE STOP INTERNALS OF CARGO TANKS GENERALLY WASTED AT TOPS NECESSITATING TEMPORARY COMPENSATION STOP WASTED PILLARS TRUNK DECK TO CENTRE DECK REINFORCE STOP SEVERAL DOUBLING PLATES REQUIRED ON DECKS STOP ALL CLOSING APPLIANCES OVERHAUL OR RENEW STOP VESSEL TO DRY DOCK AND TANKS PREPARE FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION STOP FOREGOING FOR LOADED LIST VOYAGE SINGAPORE TO UK"
