We would advise you that the above named vessel has been sold subject to inspection afloat and in drydock, to the British Colombia Steam Ship Co., and in this connection it will be necessary to make a voyage in ballast from Singapore to Vancouver. The vessel is sold "as lies" at Singapore. We shall however, appreciate your authorising your Surveyor at the above port to issue a Seaworthy certificate for the proposed voyage, alternatively to let our associates in Singapore know what the requirements are for this voyage, as we are anxious to ascertain the extent of repairs considered necessary, before making arrangements about actual drydocking.

We shall appreciate your cabling the Singapore Surveyor in this connection. For your guidance we are also cabling our Singapore Office in this connection.
