We beg to forward herewith our Report No. 71319 upon three main boilers manufactured by Messrs. The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co. Ltd. as their No. 307 B. and now being supplied to the new Standard Steamer "WAR HAVEN", Messrs. Blyth Shipbuilding Co's No. 206.

As previously intimated the engines being fitted on board this vessel are Messrs. McKee & Baxter's Contract No. 897, constructed under the survey of the British Corporation, which Society is accordingly supervising the installing of both engines and boilers.

It is presumed that the Society will, in respect of the survey of these boilers, be credited on completion with one quarter of the machinery proportion of the total survey fees based upon gross tonnage, but we should be glad to receive your confirmation on this point and also instructions as to whether an account for such proportion should be rendered in due course from this Office to the Boiler Makers.
