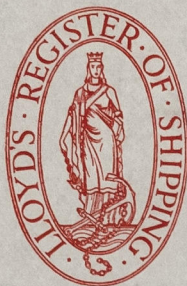

Main engine crankshaft Nos. 5 and 6 main journals and bearings.

Main engine thrust block shaft and bearings.

Main engine port and forward lubricating oil coolers.

Main engine gear box lubricating oil cooler.
