Dear Sir,

I have your letter of the 5th March, respecting the Tug "ESSO READING".

The Surveyor who has had the vessel under survey, states that the following fire extinguishing apparatus is fitted in the machinery spaces of the ship:-

- 2 - 2 Gallon, Foam Fire Extinguishers, Dual Seal.
- 1 - 1 Quart, C.T.C. Fire Extinguisher (fitted in vicinity of switchboard).
- 1 - Sand bin and scoop.

In addition, you may care to have it on record that to complete the total fire fighting equipment of the ship, there is, stowed on deck and in the accommodation the following items:-

- 2 - 2 Gallon, Foam Fire Extinguishers, Dual Seal.
- 3 - Fire buckets.
- 1 - Fireman's axe.
- 2 - 20 Ft. lengths of 2 1/2" hose.
- 1 - 30 Ft. " " " "
- 2 Directors and special spraying nozzle for dealing with oil fires.
- The hydrants, 1P 1S, ~~were~~ situated on the Upper Deck, abreast the machinery casing.

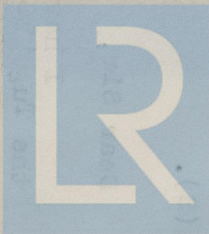
